12/9/2011 -ADSC Rocky Mountain Chapter Meeting Minutes

Call To Order: The meeting was held at Hayward Bakers office in Broomfield, CO and called to order by Charles Braun at 11:30 a.m.

Review and Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes: Minutes were approved as read noting one date correction.

Treasurer Report: The Chapter's account balance at our last meeting was \$9829.15. On December 5, 2011, five hundred dollars was donated to the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation in memory of Greg Watson w/ Hayward Baker. This donation was voted upon and unanimously approved by our BOD's. The Chapter's current account balance is \$9329.15.

Business:

National Update: National ADSC 2012 Equipment & Conference will be held from March 14th thru 17th in San Antonio, Texas. More information on the expo and upcoming National events can be found on ADSC's website at www.adsc-iafd.com.

2012 ADSC/DFI Drilled Shaft Seminar: John Hart w/ Coggins & Sons is putting together topics and speakers for the Event. The Drilled Shaft Seminar has been tentatively planned for September 12 & 13, 2012 at the Sheridan Denver West Hotel in Lakewood, CO. Presentations are planned on the 12th and the morning of the 13th. After conclusion of the morning presentations on the 13th, attendees will have the option to attend a few hour long field trip to DROS to see drill rigs in action. Lunch will be provided at the DROS site. Jan w/ National will move forward with booking the hotel and meeting space.

ASCE, AEG and CAGE will be hosting a bi-annual seminar in Denver in November of 2012. The theme of the 2012 seminar will be "GeoChallenges: Rising to Geotechnical Challenges in Colorado." The seminar will focus on case histories of challenging geotechnical projects in Colorado and the Rocky Mountain Region. Golden is part of this acquisition. According to Todd, there's a chance that once the property becomes Martin Marietta, it will not be available to DROS. Tony and Mike will follow up with Todd after the first of the year to verify availability. Other potential DROS sites were identified at the meeting. Mick Muller w/ Yenter indicated that their yard may be available. Spencer w/ Hayward Baker indicated the Quarry off Hwy 93, which is believed to be owned by Pioneer Sand and Gravel Company, may be a potential site. The APC Asphalt Co. Quarry across from Pioneer and the Colorado School of Mines were also mentioned as potential sites.

It was agreed that the hotel and classroom meeting space for DROS would not be reserved until a site was confirmed. Charles offered to check with local drill rig companies to see if they would be willing to donate a drill rig to drill a few exploratory borings at the DROS site once identified.

RM Chapter Bylaws: Bylaws are being reviewed by National and are due back after the first of the year. Charles will forward the final by-law document to the members for review once received. Our goal is to vote them into place at our next chapter meeting.

White Paper IBC/Mircopile Grout Cover: Charles handed out a preliminary draft of the white paper at the meeting. The paper is being reviewed by John Hart and others. We will revisit this topic at our next chapter meeting. Our goal is to submit the white paper to the Micropile Committee at the National meeting in March.
